Candidates must be affiliated in Lodge, Chapter and Council.

There can be no ballot in less than two weeks.

Committee must report in writing before balloting.

Jurisdiction in Mississippi is concurrent except within the city limits of a town where a Commandery is located.

Candidate must have resided six months within Jurisdiction of the Grand Commandery of Mississippi.

Rejected candidate cannot be received in less than three years without unanimous consent of rejecting Commandery, but may be renewed in six months in rejecting Commandery.

Two applicants cannot sign same petition.
